## Component Quality Engineer - Mountain View

- Investigate failures and coordinate failure analysis, determine root causes; categorize failure as related to components, process or design.
- Provide support to Design Engineering, Manufacturing, Commodity Management, and Supplier Quality teams on the selection, sourcing, qualification, and application of components used in our servers and network systems.
- Participate in on-going supplier performance evaluations and improvement strategies.

Planning and strategy for a company are exempt duties. This position seems to be involved with workflow optimization and setting policy of the company's general business operations. As such, this position is likely Exempt under the Administrative Exemption.

#### Requirements:

- BS degree in a technical discipline Preferably Electrical Engineering.
- Minimum 5 years experience in the field of components engineering or related field.
- Expertise in server or network products components including PCB, active and passive components, power supply, DIMM, optical fiber cable and transceivers.
- Knowledgeable in initiatives such as LEAN manufacturing, six sigma, 5S, TQM .

If you are involved to a significant degree with 6 Sigma, TQM, etc, you are likely Exempt under the Administrative Exemption

- Ability to successfully work across multiple levels of a organization.
- Familiarity with RoHS, WEEE, UL, and ASTM standards.
